THE SOLO RESIDENCY

DESIGNED FOR 1 SOLO ARTIST + 2 GUESTS

- 8 Hours Per Month of studio time, applicable to:
 - Monday-Friday
 - 8AM-5PM
- \$15/hour + tax for the first 8 hours
- \$18/hour + tax for every hour after (subject to availability)
- Only 1 Solo Artist can be on the residency, 2 guests permitted for creative purposes (not for profit)
 - Ideal for aspiring OR full time professional dancers
 - Ideal for choreographers, creative directors
- 72 hour notice to reschedule
- 1 to 3 month commitment available



- 8 Hours Per Month of studio time, applicable to:
 - Monday-Friday
 - 8AM-5PM
- \$18/hour + tax for the first 8 hours
- \$21/hour + tax for every hour after (subject to availability)
- Suited for showcase, performance and low budget projects for 30 or less artists for first time show creative OR non-for-profit/low budget independent shows with limited sponsorships or financial help:
 - Ideal for funded showcases/performances with valid proof.
 - Ideal for independent artists, dancers, movement based researchers.
 - Research and theory based dance projects.
 - Non-for-profit company rehearsals, cultural workshops & youth based dance classes.
 - Rehearsals for festivals
- 1 to 3 month commitment available

ABOUT

MAKE US YOUR CREATIVE HOME.

A program created with the intention to bring support, accessibility, and opportunity to the dance community. Artists will have access to the space from 8am-5pm Monday through Friday under their respective membership fees.

THE GOAL.

We're offering substantial financial support on studio rental hours for a select few monthly. We aim to make meaningful impact for artists in Toronto.

HOW IT WORKS.

Book your hours for the month anytime before the month starts. You can book new or reoccurring hours as you wish (based on availability). Your account will be charged on the 1st of the month. Additional hours are billed separately.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Must be an aspiring or full time working artist (dancer, choreographer, creative director).
2. Have a purpose and/or project in the works in which the space will be utilized with intention.
3. Must be able to convey in words via the application form the nature of the rental and answer questions accordingly.
4. Must be a Canadian resident.
5. Valid credit card for membership charges.

HOW TO APPLY

1. Verify that we have memberships available by emailing the hub.
2. Fill out the application form.
3. If you are reached out to with an acceptance, a phone call or email may be required to review any final information.



- Passionate and motivated applicants in need of the residency for creative and financial assistance for a specific project.
 - A solo or collective group with a commitment to dance excellence. Must have work experience in the dance field.
- TIP: a strong written application with detail will help your application.

RESIDENCY PROGRAM

POLICIES

1. Must have a valid credit card on file, payment will be processed on the 1st of each month. No cash, e-transfers or debit permitted. Hours are non-transferable between months.
2. The artist on the residency title is responsible to book their own space each month, recurring times/spots are permitted on a recurring basis.
3. Unused hours or inactive accounts may be subject to termination to open the opportunity to fellow cre8tors.
4. Once the application is accepted, a contract with the length of the residency will be stated. The artist must follow all contract policies as stated until the end of their residency.
5. 2 hour booking minimum per day. 1 hour bookings may be available but not guaranteed.
6. Failed transactions will be subject to a \$20.00 administrative fee.
7. Artists who abuse the residency program such as but not limited to (see below), will be subject to immediate termination with zero tolerance in respect for the other artists and the hub itself.
 - a. Do not start/finish on time.
 - b. Abuse the guest limit based on the residency accepted (R-ONE: Limit of 2 guests per day, R-TWO: limit of 30 dancers).
 - c. Make a profit from hosting classes, privates or sessions open to the public, friends, colleagues etc.
 - d. Invalid usage of the space different from the original project's outline, goal, funding, timeline etc.
 - e. Do not clean up after yourself or guests and garbage behind in the studio.
 - f. The studio was not put back in the same condition it was left in.
8. Due to the time in which the program will be running, however unlikely, the hub is entitled to ask to maintain speaker levels at its lowest during a specific time, day(s) or special circumstances, out of respect for other businesses.
9. There is no cancellation or refunds. You cannot give away your residency to someone else, this will result in membership annulment.
10. There is no guarantee which studio will be available. A notice will be given if there's a change in the booking.
